The world's favourite storyteller

Hans Christian Andersen, who is universally famous for writing fairy tales—his 156 stories are the most translated fiction in history—did not have the best start in life.


He was born in a one-room house in Odense, Denmark on 2nd April, 1805. His father was a shoemaker and his mother a washerwoman. When Hans was eleven his father died and his mother sent him to work in a tailor's shop and later a tobacco factory to help support the family. When he was fourteen, he left home to seek his fortune in Copenhagen. He had a very troubled time trying to earn a living working in the theatre. Fortunately, Jonas Collin, a theatre director, encouraged him to finish his education, and, when he was 17, Hans went back to school. In 1828, aged 23, he entered university in Copenhagen.



After leaving university, Hans began writing stories based on folk legends and his own imagination. In 1835, he published *Fairy Tales for Children*. Adults and children, in Denmark and abroad, loved the stories and wanted more. Hans wrote many more stories and even now, over a century and a half after his death in 1875, the author's tales are popular all over the world. Amongst them are lasting favourites such as *The Ugly Duckling, Thumbelina, The Little Match Girl* and *The Princess and the Pea*.
