Glossary

Brew

leave until mixed together

Lid

the cover on top of the pot

Plunger unit

the part of the coffee pot that you push down to finish making the coffee

Scalding

extremely hot

Tablespoon

a large spoon

Instructions

1. First, put the pot on a dry, flat surface. Pull the plunger unit straight up and out of the pot.
2. For each cup, put 1 tablespoon of ground coffee into the pot.
3. Next, pour hot (not boiling) water into the pot. Leave some space at the top. Stir the mixture with a plastic spoon.

WARNING: metal spoons can damage the glass pot.

4. Then place the plunger unit on top of the pot and turn the lid to close off the pour spout opening. Do not press down. Let the coffee brew for at least 4 minutes.
5. Hold the pot handle firmly, then press gently on top of the knob to lower the plunger straight down into the pot.

WARNING: if you push too hard, scalding water may shoot out of the pot.

6. Finally, turn the lid to open the pour spout and then pour the coffee.

How much will I save with the SWIMSAVE card?

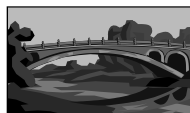
