**Granville Toaster****Features of your toaster**

1. Bread slots
2. Cancel button
3. Browning control knob
4. Indicator lights
5. Control lever
6. Crumb tray
7. Cord storage
8. Separate warming rack

**Glossary**

**Bread slots** — spaces where the bread goes in

**Browning control knob** — turns the heat up or down

**Indicator lights** — show that the power is on

**Control lever** — holds the bread down for toasting

**Separate warming rack** — metal holder for buns, croissants, rolls etc

**Instructions for using your toaster**

1. Put the plug into an electric socket and turn the power on.
2. Put up to two slices of bread in the bread slots.
3. Choose your browning setting from No. 1 to No. 6 on the browning control knob (No. 1 = lightest, No. 6 = darkest).
4. Press the control lever down. Toasting will start automatically.
5. When it is ready, the toast comes up. You can stop the toast at any time by pressing the Cancel button.

Please note: If the toaster is not plugged in and switched on at the power point the control lever will **not** stay down.
