



Glossary

Mains electricity—electricity that runs through the whole house

Set—put

'The mains'—the place where mains electricity comes from

OPERATION

Place the CD player on a dry surface away from heat and damp.

Mains operation

Set the power switch to the AC position. Set the function switch to the OFF/TAPE position. Turn the CD player upside down. Carefully remove the battery compartment cover. The AC power cord and plug are inside the battery compartment. Pull them

out carefully and replace the battery cover. Push the mains plug into the wall socket and switch the mains power on.

Using the radio—FM reception

Extend the FM antenna fully. Set the MW/FM band selector to 'FM stereo'. Set the function switch to 'tuner'. Select your favourite station with the tuning knob. Move the antenna to get the best sound.
