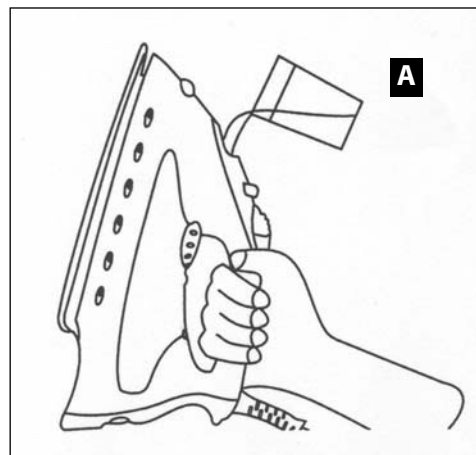
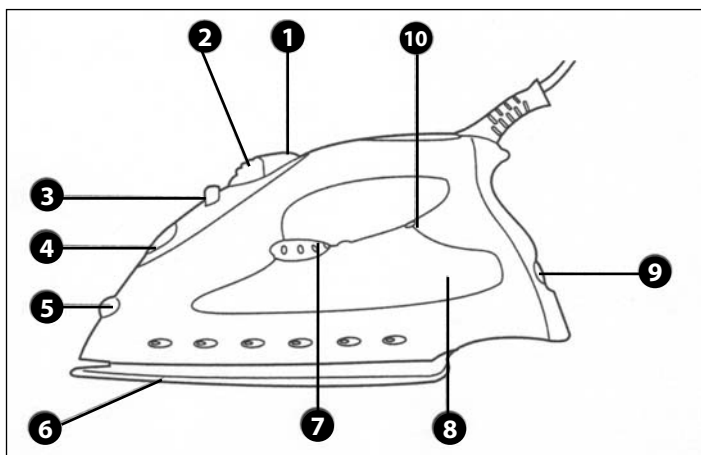

Instructions—Filling your Morphy Richards steam iron

1. Before filling the iron with water make sure the iron is not plugged in.
2. Set the dial at ③ to the '0' position.
3. Fill the beaker **A** with water.
4. Remove the fill cap and pour water through the filling hole ④ into the water tank ⑧.
5. The tank is full when the fill level line 'Max' is reached.
6. After filling replace the cap.
7. Always pour out the remaining water after use.

WARNING: When filling your iron with tap water always use the beaker provided. Never fill directly under the tap.
