



#### Glossary

- Shot of steam button—press the button to shoot out steam
- 2 Spray button—press the button to spray water
- 3 Variable steam control—changes the amount of steam
- Filling hole with cap—the place to put in the water
- **5** Spray nozzle—where the water sprays out of the iron

- 6 Soleplate—the metal base
- **7** Temperature control dial—changes the temperature
- Water tank—the place for the water
- Life long anti-scale (certain models only)—keeps the water clean
- Temperature indicator light—shows the iron is ready to use

#### Instructions—Filling your Morphy Richards steam iron

- 1. Before filling the iron with water make sure the iron is not plugged in.
- 2. Set the dial at 3 to the '0' position.
- 3. Fill the beaker **A** with water.
- 4. Remove the fill cap and pour water through the filling hole 4 into the water tank 3.
- 5. The tank is full when the fill level line 'Max' is reached.
- 6. After filling replace the cap.
- 7. Always pour out the remaining water after use.

WARNING: When filling your iron with tap water always use the beaker provided. Never fill directly under the tap.
