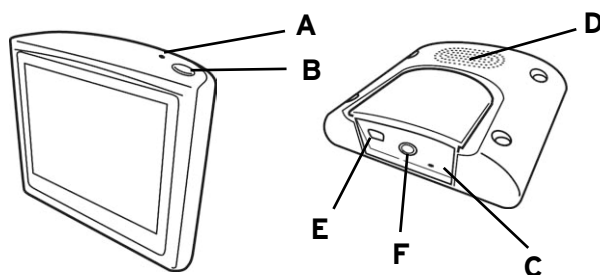

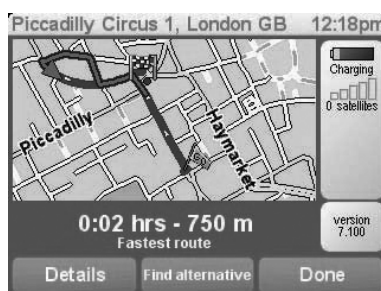
To plan a journey:

1. Touch the screen. The Main Menu comes up.
2. Press 'Navigate to'.
3. Press 'Address'.

Now you have four choices:

- i) **City Centre** – gives you instructions to get to the centre of a city or town.
 - ii) **Street and house number** – gives you instructions to get to an exact address.
 - iii) **Postcode** – gives you instructions to get to a postcode.
 - iv) **Crossing or intersection** – gives you instructions to get to a place where two streets meet.
4. Choose 'Street and house number'.
 5. Type the name of the town you want to visit.
 6. Type the name of the street you want to visit.
 7. Type the house number and then press 'Done'.

Your SatNav will take you to your address.
