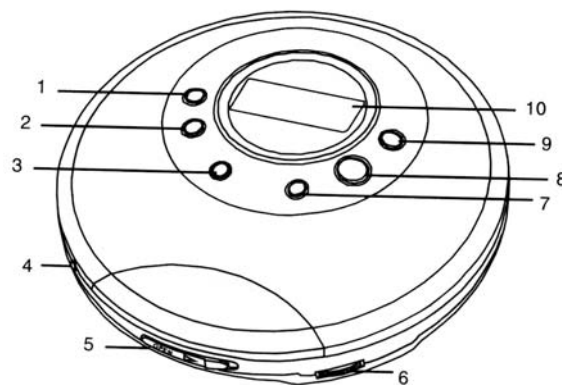

- Put the earphones into the Earphone jack to use the earphones.
- Press the Play/pause button. The LCD visual display will light up and show which song is playing. To stop the song for a short time, press the Play/pause button. Press it again to continue playing the song.
- To hear the song again, press the Repeat button. To go to the next song, press the Forward skip button.
- Use the Volume control to turn the sound up or down.
