CertTESOL: Certificate in TESOL

The Trinity CertTESOL is an initial teaching qualification designed to equip trainees with the basic skills and knowledge needed to take up their first post as an English language teacher.

- ▶ Full-time or part-time study options
- ▶ Five units – a minimum of 130 hours
- ▶ Contemporary theory and practice

Trainees complete five units: Teaching Skills, Language Awareness & Skills, Learner Profile, Materials Assignment and Unknown Language.

TYLEC: Teaching Young Learners Extension Certificate

The Trinity TYLEC is an in-service qualification designed to equip qualified English language teachers with the skills and knowledge to teach English to 7-16 year-olds.

- ▶ A minimum of 50 hours
- ▶ Workshops and tutorials
- ▶ Assisted lesson planning
- ▶ Teaching observations

TYLEC is designed to build knowledge, understanding and confidence in areas such as classroom management, lesson planning and using resources.

DipTESOL: Diploma in TESOL

The Trinity DipTESOL is for experienced teachers of English who wish to progress in their careers. At Level 7 on the UK qualifications framework, it supports the development of professional knowledge and expertise, and the refinement of practical teaching skills.

- ▶ Full-time, part-time, or blended study
- ▶ 150 hours, plus 450 hours of self-study
- ▶ Focuses on individual professional development
- ▶ Includes reflective practice and personal research interests
- ▶ Carries credits for UK Level 7 MA degrees
